



Delousing Your Environment

These steps need only be performed once if the LouseBuster™ was performed on the members of your family that had head lice.

BEDROOMS

Strip all bedding that has been used prior to treatment and dry for 30 min on high heat. This should be done after each application of oil if treating at home.

LIVING AREAS, DENS, AND BASEMENTS

Lint roll all furniture where heads have come in contact within 24 hours.

BATHROOMS and KITCHENS

1. Any recently used towels should be laundered.
2. Sanitize brushes and combs by removing any loose hair and choosing one of the following:
 - * Place all items in a plastic bag and freeze for 24 hours.
 - * Run accessories through the dishwasher under the sanitation cycle.

VEHICLES and MISC. ITEMS

1. After treatment, vacuum or lint roll car seats.
2. Purses, backpacks and coats should be lint rolled or dried on high heat for 30 min.
3. Sports helmets can be lint rolled or vacuumed before each use, especially if they are shared with other teammates.

HELPFUL NOTES...

- Lice do not jump or fly; they crawl and trapeze from head to head.
- Human head lice are host specific; they will not infest your animals.
- Keep hair pulled back and use hairspray or hair gel to minimize the chance of acquiring or spreading head lice. Rapunzel's Louse Away detangling spray is a highly efficient repellent. We also sell repelling shampoo.
- Check clothing with a lint roller for loose hairs on a regular basis.
- If children share a locker, cubby or coat closet at school, have them place their belongings inside a zipped backpack or trash bag.
